

The Kiosk Still Shut

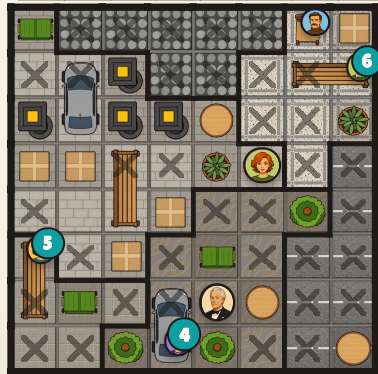
EASY · 8×8 · 7 SUSPECTS



1 **Bruno** was sitting on a chair: only one square fits. **Row 1, column 7**, at the Doorway.

2 **Alice** was in a corner of the Sidewalk. By her card, Flora must be in column 2. Two rows south, a woman was next to a plant (Edward's card). **Row 4, column 6**, on the Sidewalk.

3 **Victor**, the victim, has no card. Rule out the rows and columns of Alice and Bruno. Carmen was southwest of Victor, and Carmen can only be in row 8, column 4. By his card, Edward must be in row 2. The victim was alone with the murderer. By his card, Gonzalo must be in row 5. **Row 7, column 5**, on the Square.



4 **Carmen** was next to a tree. Rule out the rows and columns of Alice and Victor. **Row 8, column 4**, on the Square.

5 **Diana** was at the Bus Stop. Rule out the rows and columns of Victor and Carmen. **Row 6, column 1**, at the Bus Stop.

6 **Edward's** card is about others, not about his own square. Rule out the rows and columns already taken. Gonzalo was south of Edward, and Gonzalo can only be in row 5, column 3. Two rows south, a woman was next to a plant. By her card, Flora must be in column 2. **Row 2, column 8**, at the Doorway.



7 **Gonzalo's** card is about others, not about his own square. Rule out the rows and columns already taken. By her card, Flora must be in column 2. **Row 5, column 3**, on the Sidewalk.

8 **Flora** was in the second column. Rule out the rows and columns already taken. **Row 3, column 2**, on the Sidewalk.

SOLUTION

The murderer was Carmen.
