

Among the Columns

VERY EASY • 6x6 • 5 SUSPECTS



- 1 Bruno was on a mat. Alice was south of Bruno, and Alice can only be in row 6, columns 2 to 6. **Row 5, column 1**, in the Stairwell.
- 2 Diana's card is about others, not about her own square. Rule out the rows and columns of Bruno. She was southeast of Edward, and Edward can only be in rows 1 to 2, column 4. Carmen was the only person on the cot. By her card, Alice must be in row 6. By his card, Edward must be in column 4. **Row 3, column 6**, in the Storeroom.
- 3 Carmen's card is about others, not about her own square. Rule out the rows and columns of Diana and Bruno. She was the only person on the cot. **Row 4, column 5**, in the Storeroom.
- 4 Victor, the victim, has no card. Rule out the rows and columns of Carmen, Diana and Bruno. The victim was alone with the murderer. By her card, Alice must be in row 6. **Row 2, column 2**, in the Stairwell.
- 5 Edward's card is about others, not about his own square. Rule out the rows and columns already taken. Diana was southeast of Edward, and Diana is in row 3, column 6. **Row 1, column 4**, in the Storeroom.
- 6 Alice's card is about others, not about her own square. Rule out the rows and columns already taken. **Row 6, column 3**, in the Camp.

SOLUTION

The murderer was Bruno.
