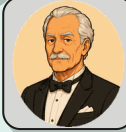


The Hall Clock

Victor

Victor has been murdered. Who did it?

Place everyone. Whoever shares a room with the victim is the murderer.

One per row and per column

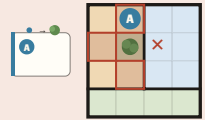
Like a sudoku. Nobody on the shaded squares.



3

Each card says where they were

"Next to" means adjacent and in the same room: walls cut.



HINT Exactly one suspect is lying: their whole card is false. The victim is not lying. Nobody was in the **Gallery**. There was one man and one woman in the **Master Bedroom**.

SUSPECTS



Alice

I was not next to a **plant**, with **Hector** and south of **Gonzalo**.



Bruno

I was next to a **painting** and not on a **rug**.



Carmen

I was in a corner of the **Wine Cellar**, with someone who was next to a **table** and northeast of **Victor**.



Diana

I was sitting on a **bench** and not next to a **table**.



Edward

I was in the **Ballroom** and in the **third column**. One column west, someone was on a **rug**.



Flora

I was next to a **fireplace**, not with **Alice** and alone with **a woman**.



Gonzalo

I was in the **fifth column** and not sitting on a **bench**. One row south, **a woman** was sitting on a **chair**.



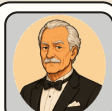
Hector

One row south, **a woman** was on a **rug**.



Irene

I was on a **rug** and not with **Hector**.



Victor

The victim. He was alone with the murderer.
